- 2. PAGE NUMBER REFERS TO THE PAGE IN CEMETERY BOOK.
- 3. THE PAGE NUMBERS MAY BE OFF BY 1 TO 3 PAGES DUE TO HOW THE NUMBERS WERE ASSIGNED BY COMPUTER WHEN COPIED TO FILES. THE CEMETERY BOOK INDICATES THE LOT OWNER ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE PAGE.

## DIMENSIONS OF A GRAVE LOT:

16 FEET WIDE, AND 20 FEET LONG. EACH LOT CONTAINS 8 GRAVES. EACH GRAVE IS 4 FEET WIDE BY 10 FEET LONG
BRICKS ( ) ARE BURIED IN THE CORNERS OF THE LOT INDICATING LOT NUMBERS. (IN SECTIONS A&B, THESE ARE MARBLE MARKERS, NOT BRICKS) GRAVES IN EACH LOT ARE NUMBERED 1 THRU 4 EAST TO WEST ON NORTH AND 5 THRU 8 EAST TO WEST ON SOUTH

4. THE MAP INDICATES HOW THE CEMETERY IS LAID OUT IN THE VARIOUS SECTIONS AND LOTS. SECTION A & B IS THE OLDEST PART OF THE CEMETERY, AND IS IN THE MIDDLE PART OF THE MAP. SECTIONS C,D AND E ARE TO THE WEST OF THE OLD SECTION. SECTION F AND G ARE TO THE EAST OF THE OLD SECTION.
