ROLL CALL

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

- d) to proceed with placing the 5-year, 2.0 mill tax levy renewal for the purpose of fire and EMS services on the ballot for the November 8, 2022 general election, and submit the documents to the Ross County Prosecutor for review, and then to the Ross County Board of Elections for placement on the November ballot.
- e) reviewed the 2023 tax budget and set the date for the public hearing for the budget as July 11, 2022 at 5:45 p.m. at the township garage. Public notice of the hearing will be posted on the township bulletin board located at the township garage.

The Trustees discussed the possibility of placing a levy on the ballot for the purpose of cemetery maintenance. Mr. Bethel said he would prefer this be done at a time when other issues are not on the ballot, such as the township's fire levy renewal.
